

SCHOOL UNIFORM REGULATIONS

Girls:

All must be no more than 2 inches above the knee:

Jumper: Grades K-2

Jumper or Skort: Grades 3-4

Skort: Grades 5-8

Pants: During cold weather, girls may wear navy blue twill pants; a notice will be sent home. Pants must be similar in style and quality to Dennis Uniform; no logos or tags showing. No cargo pockets. Pants must fit to waist, no hip-huggers; no bellbottoms. Pants must be reasonably close to the original color navy blue. 4th through 8th grade girls must wear a belt.

Hairbands/clips: The intent should be to restrain the hair, not for adornment or to detract from the uniform; white, navy, black or school plaid; should not have obvious glitter or sequins; should not extend excessively from the head. Dennis Uniform options are the standard for comparison.

Boys:

Pants: Navy-blue twill. Pants must be similar in style and quality to Dennis Uniform; no logos or tags showing. No cargo pockets. Pants must fit to waist, no sagging; no flairs or bellbottoms. Pants must be reasonably close to the original color navy blue. 4th through 8th grade boys must wear a belt.

Boys and Girls:

*Shirt: White short-sleeved polo with a blue "S J S" monogram.
White long-sleeved polo with a blue "S J S" monogram. (Students may not wear long-sleeved white shirts under their short-sleeved polo.)*

Sweater: Navy-blue, "V" neck or crew neck (sweater only) pullover with a white "SJS" monogram. Navy-blue "1/4 Zip" sweatshirts with a white "S J S" monogram may be also worn.

Socks: Solid white socks which are clearly visible at all times. Girls may wear white or navy blue tights during winter.

Shoes: Solid white, black or dark blue leather or tennis shoes (may have a trace of other colors, no lights or patterns) which cover the entire back of the heel; no boots or over the ankle shoes.

Belts: Belts are to be black, brown or navy; may be leather or woven, not more than 3" longer than buckle; no rivets, studs or designs; no large or advertising buckles.

Jacket: Solid navy-blue or black, with or without school monogram, no logos, stripes, etc.

Shorts: Girls and boys may wear navy-blue twill walking shorts during the hot weather (No nylon or stretch materials, must have a belt). Shorts must be no longer than the middle of the knee and no shorter than 2" above the knee. "Cargo" shorts with pockets are not allowed. Shorts may be worn at the beginning of school in the summer. A notice will be sent home when shorts are no longer allowed in the fall, and again when they will be allowed in the spring of each year.

Jewelry: Bracelets are not allowed. Necklaces must not be worn outside the uniform or visible.

Cold Weather Attire:

Students may wear hats, scarves or gloves when they arrive in the morning, but they must be removed before entering the classroom, and not worn again during the day. This is a privilege that may be rescinded if abused.

Friday Attire:

Because the School attends Mass on Friday mornings, students are to wear appropriate attire. Girls are to wear Jumper or Skort; Boys are to wear long pants.

Monday Attire:

Students are allowed to wear a current Jog A Thon tee shirt that is in good condition on Mondays only. Students may also wear the "Spirit Wear" tee shirt or the Kobe Garcia tee shirt on Mondays as well. The Spirit Wear sweatshirt is not an element of our uniform, even on Mondays.

Sports and Extra-curricular Activity Attire:

Students participating in sports, including both practices and games, and in other extra-curricular activities, are expected to conform to the general expectation that their dress be appropriate, modest and reflect the values of our school.

Free Dress Regulations:

On an occasional basis, particular students, or the entire student body may be allowed to wear clothing outside the uniform regulations. Sometimes, this dress is specific, such as "Red, White and Blue" attire. At other times it is not, however, certain regulations always pertain:

- ❑ *Students may wear clothes/shoes of any color; hats are okay, off inside rooms!*
- ❑ *Students may wear denim; no ragged knees, cuffs or other! (Girls may wear pants.)*
- ❑ *Clothing may have appropriate logos (sports, etc.).*
- ❑ *Clothing may not be any less modest than uniform, i.e. no tight-fitting, sagging, bare shoulders/midriiffs, or shorter than skort/shorts.*
- ❑ *Shoes must cover entire foot, boots okay (no sandals).*
